As you will know by now Brookfield has reopened on schedule following the redevelopment of the Courts, Floodlighting and the external environment generally.

The final part of this work was the installation of an electronic system for access control to the grounds and within the building and for the operation of the Floodlights.

Your Brookfield Fob

Attached to this letter you will find a Fob. Although it has no print on it, this is unique to you and is embedded with your identity. You will need to bring it with you to Brookfield **at all times** so as to gain access to the Club. If you lose your Fob, please ask a parent to contact the Club as soon as possible so that the Fob can be replaced. Once we know of the loss of the Fob the original is rendered useless as it will be electronically blocked.

The system will go live on Monday 27th August and you will need your Fob with you from that date to access the Club.

Accessing the Club

There will be magnetic locks on the

- new pedestrian security gate
- main door
- Bar door
- Kitchen door
- Ladies Changing
- Gents Changing

Junior Members will only have access through the pedestrian security gate, the main door and either the Gents or Ladies changing rooms depending on gender.

To enter any of these gates/doors, you will need to hold your Fob within a few millimetres of the “reader” that you will see on the outside of each of these gates/doors. You will then have 5 seconds to open the gate/door once the light goes to green from red. On the inside of each door there is a white release button that you must press to leave the room within 5 seconds. On the pedestrian security gate the release button to exit is a few metres down the walkway for security reasons. **Junior Members must not open this gate for anyone else. Every member has been issued with a Fob or Card.**

Operating the Floodlights

It will be up to your parents to decide whether they want you to be able to operate the Floodlights using your Fob. They have been informed of this in a separate letter.
